



TO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF ONTARIO:

WHEREAS the cost of gasoline has been increasing alongside the cost of living, causing hardship for many residents of Ontario; and

WHEREAS, the government already collects about \$3.7 billion in revenue from motorists annually; and

WHEREAS, gasoline tax revenues go exclusively to big cities with transit systems, while roads and bridges crumble in smaller and rural communities all across Ontario; and

WHEREAS, raising the gasoline tax will hurt the economy and cost the province jobs; and

WHEREAS, many residents across Ontario object to paying increased gas taxes of up to \$.10/litre in order to fund subway and transit developments specific to the City of Toronto and the GTA/GTHA;

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, do hereby petition the Government of Ontario to reverse course on its plan to afflict the families and businesses of the province with an increase to the gas tax and instead urge the government to look for savings within the system to cover the costs for any transit expansion in the City of Toronto.
